Recreation: Councilman Snyder made the council aware that the contract for the Recreation Park at Fairview Avenue expires in June 2026. Councilman Snyder discussed the following breakdown of costs for the Borough to maintain the park: Mowing/Trimming \$9,120, Weed Spraying \$496, Trash Pickup \$1,920, Port A Pots 2,880, Preparing for Baseball Field Use 3,420, Preparing for Football Field Use \$1,681, Repairing Dugouts after storm \$1,000, Repairing dugouts after Vandalism \$2,000, New Football fencing for parking area \$349. Councilman Snyder also discussed that in 2026 there would be costs for the following items: new signage, cameras/signs at dugouts, Sealing the basketball courts, new tennis courts. Councilman Snyder requested that any residents that wanted to provide the council with input on this matter to come to the March council meeting to give public comment regarding the renewal of the contract.
